Morgan County Tennessee Did you Know?



Morgan County was established Oct. 15, 1817.

The Courthouse was built in 1904. The tower houses a 900-pound bell and four-sided clock with four-foot hands. The only other clock of its kind resides in the Smithsonian.

Morgan County is the only county in the state with two National Parks: Big South Fork National River & Recreational Area and Obed Wild & Scenic River.

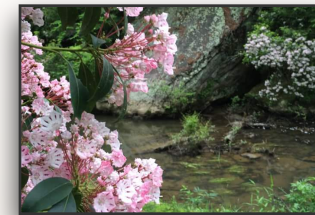
